HARRIS & ASSOCIATIES, INC. FOR INDEPENDENT PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT SERVICES FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2020 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2022, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
