B. Brady conveyed she asked the Finance Director to bring back current information on the City's debt service at next month's meeting, so they have a handle on which accounts are debt heavy, and what they're spending on debt service.

Amy Hendricks reminded residents to make sure they're filing a RITA return.

She said information they became aware of in the last few days when working with bond counsel at Squires and financial advisors at Sudsina & Associates is that with the decreased fluctuation in interest rates, the City secured financing that was affordable within the projected cash flow for the water meter project, and the City will have it paid off in 10 years, which is great news.
