## TOPIC ONE:Liberty Waterline (Between Vermilion Rd. & Park Drive) CostEstimates

C. Howard said at the last committee meeting, council asked him to put together a cost estimate for this project. The Liberty Avenue Waterline replacement from Vermilion Road to Park Drive is \$209,660.00 based on directional drilling, which has less impact to sidewalks and restoration. They would have to bore under the road to get to Park and Portage. He said this may require an easement from Romps. F. Loucka asked if there was outside money available for this section. C. Howard said the city did not apply for any money. He said they had a lot of issues with closing down the water for Vermilion Road, Phase 1 as it impacted Romps and Park Drive, and a lot of the businesses (Huggy's/Quaker Steak).

S. Holovacs asked if the city would look for available money because this is the last phase to take them to the bridge. C. Howard said it is not on the list but eventually it needs to be done if council would consider it.

F. Loucka adjourned the meeting upon no further discussion.
