- Successfully complete the minimum training required for OPOTC Certification

Application Process:

All full-time candidates are required to take and pass an annual written Civil Service examination. An additional physical agility test is required for officer candidates.

Those seeking part time employment only need to fill out an application and submit it at the VPD Station. The VPD accepts part time employment applications for Officers or Dispatchers on an open and continuous basis.

All candidates are subject to written (full-time), physical, psychological, CVSA, and performance-based testing as well as a background investigation and interview process.
